

## ADVANCED ENTRY AGREEMENT

between

**THE ROBERT GORDON UNIVERSITY**, a body corporate incorporated under The Robert Gordon University (Establishment) (Scotland) Order 2006, a Scottish Charity (Charity Number SC013781) and having its principal administrative office at Garthdee House, Garthdee Road, Aberdeen, AB10 7QB ("RGU")

and

**TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM OF GEORGIA**, a State of Georgia Agency responsible for the oversight and operations of postsecondary technical colleges, adult literacy programs, the "Quick Start" program and other programs and services pursuant to the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (O.C.G.A.) § 20-4-14 et. seq.; and having its principal administrative office at 1800 Century Place NE, Atlanta, Georgia 30345, (the "Partner")

(together the "Parties")

### 1. Purpose

This Agreement specifies the eligibility requirements for students on the stated Technical College System of Georgia course(s) to apply for entry with advanced standing to the named degree courses(s) offered by RGU.

<p>Conditions of application to the above RGU course:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Satisfactory completion of the above named course with a total of 60 credits including the required electives: MGMT 2205, MGMT 1105 and MKTG 1370</li> <li>- A grade point average of 3.0 or above.</li> <li>- A reference deemed suitable by RGU from a relevant TCSG Partner Institution faculty member.</li> <li>- Where an applicant's first language is not English, satisfactory evidence that they meet the general English language requirements of RGU may be required.</li> <li>- Applicants must be eligible to obtain the requisite visa to enter the United Kingdom for study purposes.</li> <li>- Entry is subject to places being available.</li> </ul>
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**3. Term**

This Agreement shall be valid for a period of 5 years from the last date of signature.

In the event that there is a change of curriculum or change to the relevant eligibility requirements, this Agreement shall terminate and the Parties shall, as appropriate, discuss entering into a revised Advanced Entry Agreement.
